What is CBO?

Since 2006, College Bound Opportunities (CBO) has been mentoring under-resourced students from the Northern suburbs of Chicago and motivating them to realize their potential as students and become productive members of their communities. CBO is a highly competitive program that seeks academically motivated students with a strong desire to graduate from college, and who would benefit from working with a mentor to guide them through the myriad of obstacles they might face on their journey. Ultimately, CBO helps these students find the confidence to believe in themselves and to visualize a better future.

The CBO Scholar?

CBO Scholars and their families reside in some of the wealthiest communities in suburban Chicago, but they live on the periphery economically, making sacrifices just to give their kids the best possible public education. For these students, it is not a matter of where they will go to college but *if* they will go.

Most of CBO's Scholars are the first in their families to attend college. Unfortunately, only 11% of first-generation college students graduate. CBO is helping its Scholars beat those odds. **Today, 95% of our Scholars have graduated or are on track to graduate college in less than five years.**



CBO Partner Schools

- ▶ CBO initially focused on supporting students at **Highland Park High School**, with **Deerfield High School** coming on board soon after. After several years of success in District 113, CBO expanded its programming to **Lake Forest High School**. Last year, we added **Cristo Rey St. Martin College Prep** in Waukegan as a partner school. We look forward to supporting students from our newest partner school, **Buffalo Grove High School**, beginning with the 2017-18 school year.
- ▶ According to data collected by the Illinois State Board of Education, there are **more than 1,200 low-income high school students attending these five high schools**. Within the college-ready confines of the north and northwest suburbs, the need for a more comprehensive support system for these vulnerable students can be overlooked.
