

Join CBO's Fundraising Team for the Newman's Own Foundation \$500,000 Holiday Challenge (November 21 – January 3)



1. JOIN THE TEAM

Click on the link below to get to CBO's landing page for the challenge. This is the "master" account through which all pages should be created so the donations count as part of the challenge!

Next, click the "Join the Team" button:



(Please note - the challenge does not start until **November 21 at 11 AM CST**, so you will see "Not Accepting Donations" button for now. Once the challenge is live it will be a "Donate Now" button.)

2. CREATE A CROWDRISE ACCOUNT

You will need to create a Crowdrise account to participate. You can choose to do it via your Facebook account or separately with an email address.



BEFORE you do any work on the CBO Holiday Campaign page, be sure to personalize your general Crowdrise account. Just click on your name as the "Organizer" (see arrow above).

You will see a screen like this:



You can personalize it as much – or as little – as you’d like. You can edit your entire profile by clicking this button on the top, left of the page:



We recommend you add a profile picture, at minimum. You can upload a profile picture from your computer by clicking on the [ADD PHOTO](#) link in this box:




Once you’ve uploaded a picture you will need to return to your challenge page. You will see a “FUNDRAISERS” heading and a box below with “CBO’S HOLIDAY CAMPAIGN” – click on that link.




3. PERSONALIZE YOUR CHALLENGE PAGE!

Once you click on that link, it will take you to the DASHBOARD for your challenge page:



Once you are on the dashboard, click the EDIT tab on the left side and your screen will look like this:



Here you will upload another photo here to serve as a COVER PHOTO for this specific campaign page. You can upload as many pictures as you want (i.e. if you are a mentor you can load photos with your mentee). Just click on the aqua camera icon to upload a picture from your computer. If you do not add a photo here, the CBO photo/video will be the default image.

You can also set your personal campaign goal. Be realistic, but know you can edit the goal as the challenge progresses if you find yourself exceeding the original goal.

Finally, it's time to edit the CAMPAIGN STORY. We encourage you to WRITE YOUR OWN STORY! Remember this will be going out to YOUR friends, family, and social networks. **Let your audience know why YOU are involved with CBO.** Why should they invest in CBO?

Remember you can always go back and edit your story! If you forget something, or want to add a different picture, just go back to your dashboard and edit.

We recommend you add the following paragraph about CBO to the end of your story:

College Bound Opportunities (CBO) mentors economically disadvantaged students to unleash their potential, graduate college, pursue meaningful professions, and inspire others to follow in their footsteps. Accepting students from Buffalo Grove High School, Deerfield High School, Highland Park High School, Lake Forest High School, and Cristo Rey St. Martin College Prep in Waukegan, CBO achieves its goals by offering 1:1 mentoring, in addition to providing academic and financial support for college. 

You can click on the VIEW tab on the left side of the screen to see how your page will look to friends and family. The page will open in a new tab, so you can edit until you are happy with your page.


4. TIPS ON SHARING!

Crowdrise makes it very easy to share your campaign to social media and via email. These are easy and effective ways to amplify our joint efforts.


From the home page, click on these buttons to share the page to your Facebook and Twitter accounts.
